

## BEARTOOTH HUMANE ALLIANCE SCHOLARSHIP



Beartooth Humane Alliance holds as its most basic mission the enhancement of the quality of life for companion animals – both for today and tomorrow. The **Beartooth Humane Alliance (BHA) Scholarship Fund** has been created to aid likeminded students to pursue a higher level of education for the betterment of companion animals. This educational investment in students ultimately pursuing a career in animal welfare provides a catalyst for the future benefit for animals.

### 1. Background

- a. The BHA Scholarship is funded by donor- restricted contributions not available to the organization for other purposes. Donations accepted for animal care and related animal welfare programs will not be co-mingled with the Scholarship Fund and will remain solely for the benefit of animals.
- b. Each year a specially appointed BHA committee will select the recipient of the BHA Scholarship (generally a \$1,000 award) from Carbon County high school applicants (see “3” below). In the event that there is no applicant deemed appropriate for the award in a given year, that year’s award will be deferred to a subsequent year. BHA also reserves the right to distribute more than one award per year and to require interviews with finalists.
- c. Current and recent graduates of Carbon County high schools who will be attending an accredited (regionally or nationally) U.S. post-secondary educational institution are eligible to apply for this award. Recipients may reapply in subsequent years.

2. **Purpose:** The scholarship is intended to support the recipient’s educational goals as they relate to careers in companion and service animal (dogs, cats, horses, etc.) welfare and training, including the administration of such programs. Career examples include: veterinary and related practices; military and police activities; personal assistance for physically or psychologically impaired individuals; search/rescue/recovery operations; assisted living facility quality-of-life enhancement; administrative management of nonprofit animal welfare organizations having missions aligned with that of BHA.

3. **Application and selection process:** Submit the entire application packet directly to BHA, PO Box 2333, Red Lodge, MT 59068 no later than **April 30, 2022**.
